 - A 19; Plans to protect public safety as it relates to terrorist activity or specific cybersecurity threats or vulnerabilities and briefings by staff members, legal counsel, or law-enforcement or emergency service officials concerning actions taken to respond to such matters or a related threat to public safety; discussion of records excluded from this chapter pursuant to subdivision 3 or 4 of § 2.2-3705.2;
 - A 29; award of a public contract involving the expenditure of public funds, including interviews of bidders or offerors, and discussion of the terms or scope of such contract;
 - A 38; Virginia Port Authority of proprietary information gathered by or for the Virginia Port Authority (records excluded from this chapter pursuant to subdivision 1 of § 2.2-3705.6);
 - A 42; Virginia Military Advisory Council or any commission created by executive order; BRAC (subdivision 12 of § 2.2-3705.2);
 - A 46; Resource management plans; personal and proprietary information that are excluded from the provisions of this chapter pursuant to (i) subdivision 25 of § 2.2-3705.6 or (ii) subsection E of § 10.1-104.7;
 - A 47; (Eff. July 1 ,2018); ABC; Board of Directors of the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority of records excluded from this chapter pursuant to subdivision 1 of § 2.2-3705.3 or subdivision 34 of § 2.2-3705.7.

As per the study plan adopted by the Council, upon completion of review of open meeting exemptions found in § 2.2-3711, the Subcommittee will review related meeting provisions, including § 2.2-3707 (notice of meetings, etc.), § 2.2-3707.01 (meetings of General Assembly), § 2.2-3707.1 (posting of minutes for state boards, commissions), § 2.2-3710 (voting), § 2.2-3712 (closed meeting procedures), and §§ 2.2-3708 and 2.2-3708.1 (electronic communication meetings).

6. Policy consideration: Meeting exemptions that reference existing FOIA record exclusions. Query: good approach or in need of change?

At previous meetings, the Subcommittee discussed whether the current meeting exemptions that reference existing FOIA record exemptions should be amended to contain more information, to include the identity of the public body(s) to which the exemption applies and a general description of the subject matter of the excluded records / topic for discussion in a closed meeting in addition to the citation to the applicable records exemption. A draft was prepared by staff, discussed by the Subcommittee, and posted on the Council website to receive further comment. No action to date on this approach has been taken by the Subcommittee.
