Thank you for your service on the FOIA Council. I hope you agree that it is important to make public service (whether elected or appointed) more accessible for all Virginians, so that we may achieve more representative, effective public policy. I urge you to vote this year to remove any state-level limit for how often a member may participate electronically.
