Meeting of the Criminal Investigative Records Subcommittee of the FOIA Council

Proposed Agenda **Annotated**

1. Call to order; introduction of subcommittee members.
2. Consideration of the 2012 draft. *At its last meeting the Subcommittee directed staff to prepare a new draft of § 2.2-3706 that would reorganize existing law for greater clarity and understanding. The draft reorganizes the existing law into subsections addressing (A) required and discretionary releases; (B) 911 calls; (C) prohibited release; (D) noncriminal records; and (E) conflict resolution. The only substantive changes intended were to add subsection (B) to address 911 calls explicitly, and to amend the existing exemption for noncriminal records to allow it to be used by all public bodies engaged in law-enforcement activities. Under current law, the noncriminal records exemption applies only to records of sheriffs and local police departments.*
